ANSI/APSP-4 2007 RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOL STANDARD UP FOR REVIEW
Comments due by August 21

(ALEXANDRIA, VA) – The Association of Pool & Spa Professionals (APSP) announces that its proposed draft revision of American National Standards Institute (ANSI)/APSP-4 2007 Standard for Aboveground/Onground Residential Swimming Pools is available for public review and comment. APSP is seeking the approval for the revisions under the accreditation procedures with ANSI. The revision describes certain criteria for the design, manufacturing, testing, care, and use of aboveground/onground residential (TYPE-O) non-diving swimming pools and their components.
